What is the Pupil Premium?

The Pupil Premium is additional funding provided by the Department for Education (DFE) to enhance the education of the most socio-economically deprived (namely those students entitled to free school meals and looked after children).

How do we spend the Pupil Premium?

The Pupil Premium is spent in an integrated and targeted way, to ensure that entitled students receive the opportunity for additional support and access to all learning opportunities.

Actions focused on learning in the curriculum

- One-to-one tuition
- Small group teaching in English and Maths
- Additional in class support
- ICT provision
- Funding residential opportunities
- Nurture groups

Actions focused on social, emotional and behavioural issues

- Human Utopia Intervention
- Appointment of a home liason officer
- One-to-one counselling
- Family learning

Actions focused on enrichment

- Music tuition
- Breakfast Club

Did you know?

The Government allocates funding based upon the following criteria:

- Your child is, or has been in care
- Qualifies for Free School Meals (you are currently on Income support or Job Seekers allowance)
- Parents serving in one of the forces, designated as Personnel Category 1 or 2.
