MEDICAL RECORDS - ASTHMA

According to our records, your child has a diagnosis of asthma.

It is an expectation that your child will have his/her own inhaler with them at all times. We also encourage parents to supply a 'spare' inhaler, clearly labelled with the child's name, to be kept securely in Reception at the academy.

New guidance from the Department of Health suggests that, as an additional precaution, schools should purchase their own Salbutamol inhalers for emergency use.

In the event of an emergency, we will assume your child can be administered the Salbutamol inhaler held by the academy. If you do not want this to be given then please complete the reply slip below and return to Reception as soon as possible.
