**IMPORTANT: YEAR 9 PARENTS EVENING – TUESDAY 10 DECEMBER 2019**

Following the launch of the online booking system, we have discovered a few discrepancies with regards to some teachers not being assigned to subjects correctly. As the event is now live in the system we are unable to make the changes at our end therefore please note the following changes:

**English – Set 9.1:**

The booking shows as Miss Hanif – this is incorrect and your appointment is now with Mrs Bjelic on the evening.

**Maths – set 9.1:**

The booking shows as Mr Pierce – this is incorrect and your appointment is now with Mrs Hallam on the evening.

**Form tutor bookings (showing as None within the booking system):**

These have been pulled through incorrectly. We do not offer form tutor appointments during parents evenings as these teachers will be seeing other parents and students about the subject they teach, therefore any appointment you have booked as 'None' will not take place on the evening. Please cancel your online booking for these.

**Teachers unavailable:**
